नोएडा। पुलिस ने पश्चिम बंगाल से ट्रेन की बोगियों में रखकर गांजा लाने वाले अंतरराष्ट्रीय तस्कर को गुरुवार को गिरफ्तार किया। उसके पास से 64 किलो गांजा बरामद हुआ, जिसे वह ई-रिक्शा में रखकर बेचने जा रहा था। उसके अलावा एक अन्य तस्कर को गिरफ्तार किया गया। उसके पास से 10 किलो गांजा बरामद हुआ। नोएडा जेल के डीसीपी यमुना प्रसाद ने बताया कि पेज-1 थाने की पुलिस गुरुवार को जांच कर रही थी। इसी थी सूचना मिली कि गांजा तस्कर झुंडपुरा बॉर्डर पर ई-रिक्शा लेकर आने वाला है। इसके बाद पुलिस टीम ने बैरिकेडिंग कर तलाशी शुरू कर दी। कुछ ही देर बाद एक व्यक्ति ई-रिक्शा लेकर आता दिखाई दिया। सहायक लगेन पर चालक को हिरासत में लिया गया। ई-रिक्शा की जांच की तो उसमें 64 किलो गांजा मिला, जिसकी अनुमानित कीमत करीब 15 लाख रुपये है। आरोपी की पहचान पश्चिम बंगाल के दक्षिण दिनाजपुर जिला निवासी नितार्द सरकार उर्फ चूपा बंगाली के रूप में हुई। वह वर्तमान में छलेरा गांव में रहता है। पुछताछ में आरोपी ने बताया कि वह पश्चिम बंगाल से ट्रेन में पांच-छह किलोग्राम के छोटे-छोटे पैकेट की पैकिंग कर अलग-अलग बोगियों में रखकर गोल्डन मिर्ची गांजा दिल्ली लाता था। इसके बाद दिल्ली से चुराए ई-रिक्शा में रखकर बेचता था। पुलिस को पता चला कि आरोपी के खिलाफ पहले से सात केस दर्ज हैं।

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स्योहारा। साइबर क्राइम के तेजी से बढ़ते मामलों को देखते हुए पुलिस क्षेत्राधिकारी धामपुर अभय कुमार पांडे लगातार क्षेत्र में जागरूकता अभियान चला रहे हैं। इसी क्रम में उन्होंने स्योहारा थाना क्षेत्र के ग्राम भगवानपुर रैनी में एक विशेष बैठक आयोजित कर ग्रामीणों को साइबर ठगी के खतरों और उससे बचाव के उपायों के बारे में विस्तार से जानकारी दी। बैठक में सीओ अभय कुमार पांडे ने बताया कि आजकल साइबर अपराधी रिश्तेदारी, इन्वेस्टमेंट, लोन दिलाने, सरकारी योजनाओं और कस्टमर केयर के नाम पर भोली-भाली जनता को ठग रहे हैं। ठग मोबाइल पर फजी मैसेज, लिंक या एपीके फाइल भेजकर लोगों के फोन का डेटा चोरी कर लेते हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि हाल में शायद के कार्ड के नाम पर भेजी जा रही एपीके फाइल के माध्यम से भी साइबर अपराधी लोगों के मोबाइल पर रिमोट एक्सेस हासिल कर लेते हैं। जैसे ही कोई व्यक्ति उस फाइल को ओपन करता है, उसके फोन की सभी निजी जानकारी सीधे ठगों के पास पहुंच जाती है और उनके बैंक अकाउंट से पैसे गायब हो जाते हैं। कार्यक्रम में इस्पेक्टर क्राइम दिनेश कुमार, वरिष्ठ उप निरीक्षक सुरजीत कुमार सहित पुलिस टीम और ग्राम के दर्जनों ग्रामीण मौजूद रहे।



मीडिआइ वाले स्थानों में फ्री वाई-फाई भी बन रहा खतरा

स्योहारा। क्षेत्राधिकारी ने बताया कि बाजार, रेलवे स्टेशन, बस स्टैंड और भीड़भाड़ वाले स्थानों पर उपलब्ध फ्री वाई-फाई हॉटस्पॉट साइबर अपराधियों द्वारा ट्रैप की तरह इस्तेमाल किए जाते हैं। ऐसे वाई-फाई का उपयोग करने से मोबाइल में मौजूद संवेदनशील जानकारी चोरी हो सकती है।

3. किसी ऐप को इंस्टॉल करने से पहले उसके डेवलपर और आवश्यक परमिशन ध्यान से पढ़ें।
4. मजबूत पासवर्ड बनाएं और सभी अकाउंट्स के पासवर्ड अलग-अलग रखें।
5. मोबाइल और लैपटॉप में एंटीवायरस और फायरवॉल हमेशा ऑन रखें।
6. दफकोड स्कैन करते समय सतर्क रहें, नकली दफकोड से सीधे आपके अकाउंट से पैसे ट्रांसफर हो सकते हैं।
7. AfyDes, TeOmViewer जैसे स्क्रीन शेयरिंग/रिमोट एक्सेस ऐप्स केवल भरोसेमंद व्यक्ति की सलाह पर ही उपयोग करें।
8. अपना मोबाइल नंबर, बैंक डिटेल, OTP किसी को भी न बताएं, चाहे सामने वाला कस्टमर केयर ही क्यों न हो।
9. ऑनलाइन शॉपिंग केवल विश्वसनीय वेबसाइट या आधिकारिक ऐप से ही करें।
10. किसी भी साइबर धोखाधड़ी की घटना पर तुरंत हेल्पलाइन 1930 पर कॉल करें।
